## WHAT IS MOTTEP?

The Minority Organ Tissue Transplant Education Program (MOTTEP), founded by Dr. Clive O. Callender, is the first national organization designed to educate minority communities on facts about organ and tissue donation and transplantation.

Since June 1993, National MOTTEP has been actively working to solve the number one problem in transplantation - the shortage of organ and tissue donors. National MOTTEP expanded to three (3) sites in 1993, and then to fifteen (15) sites across the country in 1995. Gift of Life MOTTEP was launched in 1995 and serves African American, Arab American, American Indian, Hispanic/Latino, Asian, and Pacific Islander populations.







# Why be a Sponsor?
